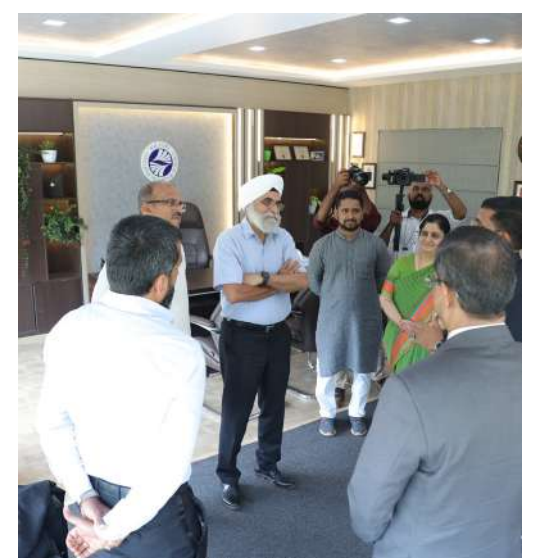


Splendid Luncheon with The NAAC Peer Members
