Digital World; A Swirling Web!

Instagram is like a Rubik's Cube. There are an infinite number of combinations to solve the game and if we don't know the trick, we are going to waste a lot of time. Much like Instagram, the algorithms dictate if we are going to see and be seen. This is a real dystopia. I remember when algorithms placed the people I interacted with the most on top. But, not anymore. The algorithms now arbitrarily decide whose posts I should be viewing. Digitally, we may feel like we can assert our power to express ourselves the way we want to, but the algorithms govern who gets to be a part of those expressions and when. Essentially, what is happening here is that certain voices are being prioritized over others, for no good reason. From the viewpoint of an open, free and equal discussion, this possess so many threats. Algorithms are complex codes that largely determine how information flows online, and how that information appears on the screen of consumers. Applications, such as Google and Instagram, use as many as 57 different signals to generate tailored

information. Again, if this isn't dystopia, then what else is? Some signals they use to create a tailored news feed include the user's geolocation, type of browser, browsing history, and digital footprint, in general. I carried out this experiment with my friend. Both of us typed "Trump" in each one of our browsers and our search page was vastly different?! Basically, the information that arrives on our screens and that enters into our minds is not as diverse as we probably tend to think it is. We, as media consumers, are no longer able to decide what enters our screens and what is edited out, even. Personally, this goes against my idea of a balanced view. Instagram is basically doing the job of gatekeeping when consumers never even ask for it. So what is at stake here? My right to view what I want to view is at stake. My right to be viewed by people closely interacting with me is erased. The viability of democracy within our world, i.e. the infosphere is at stake. Gone are the days of serendipity and chance happenings, Instagram won't allow it. Everything is already curated for us!!
